To reach out and serve the needs of the sick, the sad and suffering members of the community through pastoral care assistance, spiritual and emotional support

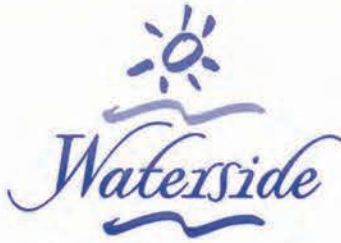

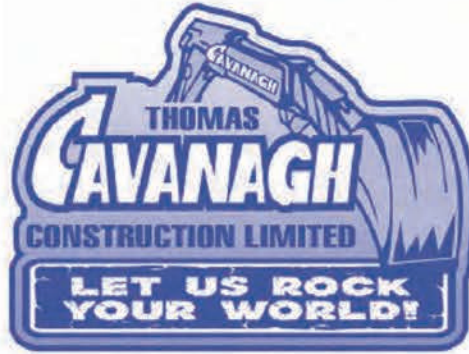
